

Paid Artist Opportunity

Artwork for the Restaurant at the Princess Elizabeth Hospital.

The PEH restaurant is the heart of the hospital bringing together staff, service users and visitors. This unique opportunity provides an artist with the exciting prospect of having a major visual impact on the hospital environment and on how a public space is experienced.


This commission is ideal for an illustrator, graphic designer or photographer. We are not looking for artwork to be displayed in frames but for a design to go directly onto the walls. The chosen design will be printed onto vinyl. The brief is divided into sections but the design must link and flow through the entire space.

Brief:

- The overarching theme for all briefs for art in a health setting, within the PEH, is to bring the outside inside connecting to nature, landscapes, seascapes and generate a sense of Hygge.
- This commission is an exciting challenge as the design will need to accommodate for all ages and disabilities. The artist will be expected to work with and be advised by the 'Accessible Art' committee.
- There is also an opportunity to integrate promotion around healthy eating and growing with in the artwork.
- As part of the commission the artist will be expected to attend a number of meetings on and off site throughout the design process.
- The artist is responsible for creating a digital image either vector or pixel to scale and to liaise with the printers.
- To artist must work to deadline and complete the project on time.
- The Artist fee will reflect the scale of the agreed design.

Entrance corridor brief:

The role of the artwork is to create a way finder including signage to the restaurant and it should feel very welcoming.



Staff Room brief:

To create a relaxing, peaceful and private environment that gives you a sense of being valued.



Main Restaurant brief:

To help create an environment that feels relaxing, contemporary, fresh, has sense of quality and privacy and is diversionary. There is a great opportunity to link directly to the views through the restaurant windows which are trees and a newly developed outside dining area.



Signage and communication:

The restaurant requires a variety of signs and we are interested in exploring and solving how we can communicate creatively and reduce the need for multiple signs around the restaurant.

- Candidates will be informed on **Wednesday the 26th of April** if they have been selected for an interview on **Friday the 28th of April**.
